Construction update Mayne Yard

From August 2020, the UNITY Alliance will continue construction within the northern area of Queensland Rail's stabling facilities at Mayne Yard as part of the Cross River Rail project.

Details of work

The activities outlined below are scheduled to occur between Saturday 29 and Monday 31 August 2020, weather and construction conditions permitting. These activities will occur outside the project's normal working hours but are timed to take place within a planned weekend track closure, as outlined below:

What to expect

During these works you may notice some intermittent disruptions such as:

- Light vehicles, trucks and machinery including excavators, mobile cranes, small power tools, drills, saws, minor vibrating equipment and mobile lighting towers to light the work areas at night
- Changes around your local area such as construction vehicles, traffic management signs and personnel
- Access to site via Lanham Street
- Some noise, vibration and dust associated with the use of heavy machinery and equipment
