Roma Street construction update

In September, demolition will continue and piling for the new Services Building will start at Roma Street site. Underground, the two roadheaders continue excavating the new station cavern.

Roma Street busway is expected to reopen in mid-September. Further information will be distributed in advance of the reopening.


