## Rescheduled: Adelaide Street Night time geotechnical investigations

Geotechnical investigations on Adelaide Street near King George Square have been rescheduled to commence from early September. These works are required to identify underground rock and soil conditions for the Cross River Rail tunnel.

The investigations are expected to take **approximately four weeks** and will involve:

- Set up of temporary traffic management on Adelaide Street
- Survey and identification of existing utility services using a vacuum excavation truck
- Excavating small holes using a truck-mounted drill rig and ground penetration rig to sample the ground conditions
- Reinstating the work area following the investigations.

### Work hours

Due to traffic restrictions, this work will occur at night between **8:00pm and 5:00am, Sunday to Thursday**. Workers may arrive onsite one hour prior to the planned start time to prepare.

### Traffic and public transport changes

The following temporary changes will be in place during this work:

- Lane closures on Adelaide Street. Vehicle access will be maintained in both directions
- Pedestrian access will be maintained past the work area
- Temporary closure of Adelaide Street Stop 20 at City Hall during night work. Bus services will stop at an alternative location during the closure. Visit [translink.com.au](https://www.translink.com.au) or the **MyTranslink app** to plan your journey.

Traffic control will be in place to assist the community through these changes. Access to properties will be maintained.

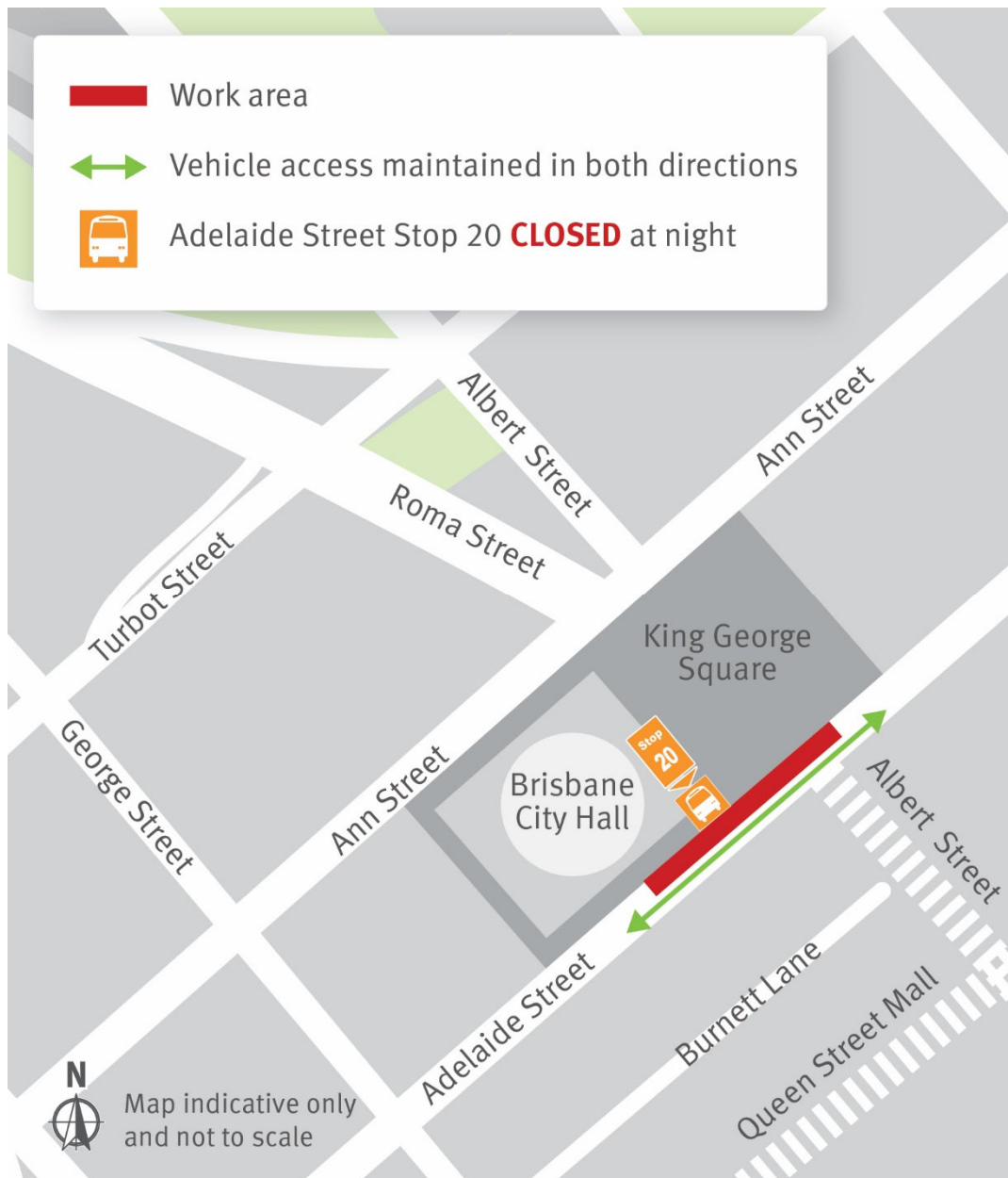
### What to expect

During these activities, the surrounding community may notice:

- An increase in construction workers and vehicles in the area
- Delivery of plant and equipment to the work area
- A potential increase in noise, dust and vibration.

Every effort will be made to keep disruption to a minimum for residents and businesses in close proximity to the project site.

Work is subject to relevant project approvals and suitable weather conditions.



### Project information

The Cross River Rail Tunnel & Stations contractor CBGU D&C JV will deliver the underground tunnel and four new underground stations at Boggo Road, Woolloongabba, Albert Street, Roma Street and an upgrade to the Dutton Park station.
